RULES OF THE OPEN ALL BREED SHOWS:

 <u>CLASSIFICATIONS:</u> <u>NOVICE HORSE:</u> <u>NOVICE RIDER:</u> <u>AMATEUR:</u> <u>PROFESSIONALS:</u> <u>CLASSES:</u> <u>ENTRIES:</u> <u>GATE:</u> <u>RIBBONS:</u> <u>LEADLINE:</u> <u>WALK/TROT/JOG:</u> <u>MINIS:</u> <u>WEANLINGS:</u> <u>SHOW GRAND CHAMPION:</u> 	ATR = Adult Amateurs 19 & over; JTR = Youths 18 & under; <u>OPEN</u> : All riders including Amateurs, Youths and Professionals. Has never won more than 3 blue ribbons in this division at any show. <u>AMATEURS ONLY!</u> Has <u>never</u> won more than 3 blue ribbons in this division in any show. One who does not accept renumeration for training, showing or giving lessons. 19 years old and older. May show in OPEN CLASSES with a number. May show in other Adult classes with number turned over. Classes of less than 3 entries may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the SHOW SECRETARY. <u>NO REFUNDS</u> . Entries <u>must</u> be made 3 classes in advance <u>or</u> enter at the gate with an open check. One (1) minute gate will be enforced. Tack changes must be requested before the class. Rosette Ribbons awarded to <u>1st through 6th Place</u> . Blue ribbons to each participant. This is not a judged class. Anyone participating in these classes <u>MAY</u> compete in all performance classes. Over-sized minis (34-38") <u>ARE</u> permitted in mini classes. Must show in a minimum of <u>2</u> shows to qualify for year-end awards (applies to weanling halter only!) "NEW - 4 SALE CLASS: (Not judged) must follow all rules as to equipment and attire. Includes all 1st place mares, geldings and stallions in classes 3 through 12.
EQUIPMENT, TACK AND CLOTHING	
1. <u>HUNTSEAT:</u> 2. <u>SADDLESEAT:</u> 3. <u>WESTERN:</u> 4. <u>TRAINING DEVICES:</u>	Huntseat attire. Jackets are optional. Boots and hats required. Saddleseat attire. Jackets are optional. Boots and hats required. Western attire. Hats and boots are required. Chaps optional. When riding with bosals or snaffles, two hands may be used. Long sleeved shirts are required. Running martingales, cavessons and snaffles are permitted. <u>No wraps, draw reins, splint boots or German martingales. This applies</u> to schooling horses too! No martingales with a curb bit! This includes schoolingno exceptions.
AWARDS	
1. <u>Daily High Points:</u>	YOU MAY ONLY CHOOSE ONE CATEGORY Consists of the greatest number of points accumulated during the show (see categories). Ties will be broken by the highest placings first, and secondly by the number classes entered. You <u>MUST</u> enter at least <u>4 classes</u> to be eligible. These can include Novice horse or rider or Walk/Jog/Trot classes. <u>YOU MUST DECLARE YOUR HIGH POINT DIVISION ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.</u>
2. TRAINER OF THE YEAR:	Each student will be given one point for each class entered for their trainer. Points will be accumulated through the year. Year-end awards will be presented at the year end Show Circuit Banquet.
3. <u>Year-end high points:</u>	Consists of the greatest number of points accumulated per show (See categories). Ties will be broken by the highest placings first, and secondly by the number classes entered. Points are tallied as follows: (1) Same horse and rider combination in Youth and Amateur qualifying classes; (2) Horse and Owner of Horse in Open qualifying classes.
4. <u>YEAR-END AWARDS:</u>	To qualify for Year-End High Point Awards, you must be a <u>paid member</u> in good standing of the Show Circuit Association. Your points will accumulate <u>when</u> you join, <u>not before</u> . You <u>must</u> show in a minimum of <u>4</u> shows in 2008 to qualify.
